

Location & Zoning

Before you lease or purchase property, engage a professional contractor, or buy equipment, follow the steps in this toolkit to save yourself time and unnecessary expenses.

Determine your desired zoning jurisdiction (city or county) for your business.

Verify your appropriate zoning designation for the type of business you intend to start.

The Planning and Zoning Department representative will assist you in determining areas within your desired jurisdiction that are compatible with the type of business you'd like to start.



If the zoning and land use of the location you desire isn't permitted for your business type, inquire about other available options related to the property or choose another compatible location that meets your needs.

Before you sign a lease or purchase...

Before you lease or purchase property, engage a professional contractor, or buy equipment, follow the steps in this toolkit to save yourself time and unnecessary expenses.

Occupying an existing space

Once you've found a property that meets compatible zoning and land use requirements for your business, make sure to do the following, before you sign a lease or purchase property.

If the previous use differs from your new intended use for the space, you will need to apply for a "change of use" which will require a safety inspection from Catawba County Building Services-Permit Center and the jurisdiction's Fire Marshall.

This step is critically important and has the potential of saving you time and unnecessary expenses.

Once approved, the Safety Inspector assigned to the case will reach out via phone call to setup a first inspection.

Determine if you need to make any alterations to the existing space.

- Alterations include but aren't limited to plumbing, electrical, mechanical, fire alarm, addition/changes to structure, or sprinkler.
- During your Safety Inspection, the Safety Inspector will advise you if an architect, licensed general contractor, or engineer needs to be involved with your project.
- If you must secure professional services to design plans for your desired alterations to your property, interview them and consult Catawba County Building Services if you need additional assistance. For a list of professional service providers, visit The Chamber's Business Directory <u>here.</u>

During your interview, ask your professional if they are aware of and familiar with building codes.

Determine if you need to involve <u>Catawba County Environmental Health</u>

- Are you considering property reliant on well and/or septic tank (ie, not connected to public water/sewer utilities?)
- Do you intend to start a food service business, mobile food unit, childcare center, tattoo establishment, nursing home, or public swimming pool?
 - If you answered yes to either or both questions, you must call Environmental Health. Don't skip this step for risk of permitting delays.

Verify the previous use of the existing space or building you plan to occupy

to ensure that the proper building codes are adhered to during the plan and design period. To determine the previous use, contact the jurisdiction's Planning Department (links & phone numbers on previous page) Upon completion of plans, you must submit your proposed plans to your zoning jurisdiction, as well as the Catawba County Building Services Department.

• Your zoning jurisdiction and/or Catawba County Building Services will approve or request changes to the plans. If the plans are not approved, you must make the appropriate changes and resubmit your plans to all entities.

When the plans are approved by all entities, you or your contractor must complete a Building Permit Application with your plans and submit it to Catawba County Building Services.

• Only then can you proceed to make the approved alterations to your space with the approved inspections required.

You may be surprised that a number of alterations may trigger a new permit, including but not limited to: expansion, demolition, deck, fence, adding a driveway or parking area, accessory structure, or any signage. If you aren't sure, call your Permitting & Zoning representative.
